GPS – Global Positioning System, a system to find a position on planet earth by using a GPS that is a piece of technology equipment that acts like a receiver and a computer to help you find a specific location by using longitude and latitude.

Latitude – the angular distance of a place north or south of the earth's equator

Longitude – the measurement east or west of the prime meridian

Prime Meridian – the zero of longitude

Equator – imaginary line that divides the globe from both poles and is the starting point of zero degrees latitude




